Highlights from the recent Council Meeting, held on 6/24.

- Trustees received an updated paint bid for exterior, good through spring 2026. They also approved a new policy regarding their oversight of decor in the church.
- Finances ended 2024 with Revenue over Expenditures of \$12,580; through May 2025 Expenditures over Revenue of \$8,665.
- SPRC will be celebrating Pastor Jen's completion of her course-of-study program during fellowship time on a Sunday in September.
- Memorial committee is updating policy and forms; referred a gazebo project to Trustees for consideration.
- Mission/Outreach will host Trunk or Treat in October and plan to carol in the park during the "Santa Bobbin into Town" event in December; thankyou to Nancy Adams and Marlowe Fortune for cooking meals for the volunteers of the 3 food shelf shifts.
- Streaming is still looking at a plan to expand the online offering beyond our doors; also working on a package-study using the Pastor's weekly message.
- 3 small groups continue to meet (Tuesday morning Bible study, Wednesday evening study, Men's group).
- Dean Fitch is putting together a group to brainstorm opportunities for the north property.
- UWF is on summer break and will resume September 4; bake sale was very successful.
- We are looking into our current security policy developed in 2019; the Conference office will be helping us evaluate our needs.
- Looking at a new model for out Executive Board/Administrative Council more to come in the future.
